Luggage Guidelines

Please contact your airline carrier for specific checked and carry-on luggage requirements such as, size, weight and quantity to verify any fees that may be associated with these items. *All luggage fees will be at your own expense.*

Checked Baggage Guidelines (Subject to Change)

American: 2 pieces – 50 lbs. each – 62 linear inches total

- 1st checked bag each way – \$25.00
- 2nd checked bag each way – \$40.00

United: 2 pieces – 50 lbs. each – 62 linear inches total

- 1st checked bag each way – \$25.00
- 2nd checked bag each way – \$40.00

Delta: 2 pieces – 50 lbs. each – 62 linear inches total

- 1st checked bag each way – \$25.00
- 2nd checked bag each way – \$40.00

Jet Blue: 2 pieces – 50 lbs. each – 62 linear inches total

- 1st checked bag each way – FREE – \$25
- 2nd checked bag each way – FREE – \$35

Luggage Tips

1. Ensure all luggage and carry-ons are labeled with your name and address.
2. Put your name, home address and phone number inside each bag. A business card is usually good for this purpose.
3. Make your bags look unique with colored tape, ribbons or stickers.
4. Use sturdy luggage and don't over pack.
5. Allow enough time for checking in at the airport to avoid confusion and mis-tagging.
6. Remove old airline destination tags.
7. Watch the skycap or airline agent as he or she puts your airline destination tags on your luggage. Look at the flight number and destination code before your bags leave you.
8. If you choose to lock your bags, the locks may be opened by an airline agent if a search is deemed necessary. It is best to leave bags unlocked, wait for them to be put through the x-ray and ask an agent to re-lock or zip-tie them once they are clear.
9. If you do not receive all of your bags at the airport, be sure to notify an agent of the airline at the airport so that a search can be initiated immediately.
